


Existing Conditions Report

Land Use and Demographics

- High rate of population and job growth
- Most workers drive alone into the city
- Aging and diverse population will continue to have new transportation needs

System Inventory

- Disjointed local street/bike lane connectivity
- Dense areas have convenient transit access
Transit service gaps exist to the North/South
- Robust pedestrian network





Existing Conditions Report

System Performance

- High traffic volumes are located near major employment campuses and retail locations
- Most severe crashes occur at intersections at a rate higher than for ODOT Region 1
- Pedestrian/bicyclist crashes occur in the downtown area and on SE 10th Avenue
- Several corridors are within the top 5% of contributors to high severity crashes in the region.
- Congestion and capacity shortfalls can have a detrimental impact on freight movement and, ultimately, on the economy.
